The Official College of Nursing of Asturias announces once again the call for the fourth nursing care photography contest. As in previous editions, the objective is to showcase nurses and their care, both professionally and personally.

All registered nurses in Asturias are invited to present their vision of the profession. It is not necessary to be a professional photographer. We want you to contribute your perspective on the profession and care. There are numerous sections with awards for everyone, with special attention to registered nurses in Asturias. Participate!

Of course, professional (and non-professional) participants are also welcome, with a specific prize section to show us how they see and value the care provided by nurses to people.

Theme:

Nurses and care towards individuals and society. Only photographs related to this theme will be accepted.

Participants:

All individuals who submit photographs within the specified deadline and in the required formats may participate. The photographs can only be submitted by their respective authors. Members of the CODEPA Board of Directors, the Asemeyando Executive Board, the jury of this contest, and their relatives are not eligible to participate.

Awards:

GENERAL: Awards for the top 3 photographs.

- Winning image with a cash prize of €300, CEF gold medal.
- 1st runner-up with a cash prize of €200, CEF silver medal.
- 2nd runner-up with a cash prize of €100, CEF bronze medal.

NATIONAL: Awards for the top 2 photographs.

- Winning image with a gift voucher for El Corte Inglés valued at €250.
- Runner-up with a gift voucher for El Corte Inglés valued at €150.

ASTURIAS NURSES: Awards for the top 3 photographs.

- Winning image with a gift voucher for El Corte Inglés valued at €250.
- 1st runner-up with a gift voucher for El Corte Inglés valued at €200.
- 2nd runner-up with a gift voucher for El Corte Inglés valued at €150.

ASTURIAS NURSES: Popular Prize for exhibited works.

- Popular prize for the most voted work in the exhibition, consisting of a Smart TV (sponsored by AMA Aseguradora), to be voted on by exhibition visitors among the displayed photographs by nurses.

- Popular prize for the second most voted work in the exhibition, with a gift voucher for El Corte Inglés valued at €150.

- Registered participants can be eligible for awards in any category but cannot receive awards in multiple categories simultaneously. The award in the category with the highest value will always be granted.

Registered nurses will provide their registration number during the process of submitting their photographs on the web platform.

- National participants can compete for the top three awards and the two national prizes, but they cannot receive awards in both categories simultaneously. The award in the category with the highest value will always be granted.

- Non-national participants can compete for the top three awards.

- The cash prizes of the contest are subject to the mandatory income tax retention (I.R.P.F.) at the prevailing rate at the time of prize delivery.

- All finalists will receive a diploma and an invitation to the award ceremony.

- The top 15% of the highest-scoring works in the general category will receive CEF rating.

- The winners will be announced through email or phone communication and made public through various media. The organization reserves the right to publish the photographs

in magazines, books, and other materials with the sole purpose of promoting and disseminating the image of nursing in Asturias and the concept of care, explicitly citing the author. There will be no profit from the dissemination of these works.

- Both the awards and the honorable mentions will be chosen by the jury of the contest, and their decision will be final.

- If a prize winner resides outside of Spain, the prize will be paid in euros, and transfer fees will be deducted.

Jury:

A qualified jury will be composed of individuals designated by Asemeyando Asociación Fotográfica and CODEPA (including a CEF jury member) who will select 20 to 30 photos from which the winners will be chosen and exhibited by CODEPA. Additionally, the jury may grant special mentions or honorable mentions to participating works that have special aesthetic, social, or professional interest. In no case will the award be monetary. The honorable mentions or special mentions will always be decided by the jury itself.

Works that do not adhere to the agreed theme or format requirements may be rejected.

The jury's decision will be made in a public and open event and will be final and unappealable.

Submission of Works:

- Registration is free.

- The maximum number of photographs that each author can submit is five (5).

- If photographs taken by the same camera are submitted under different names, all implicated authors will be automatically disqualified.

- All essentially photographic genres and techniques are allowed. However, infographics will not be accepted for the contest. Images representing the process of nursing care will be valued, in any aspect, both within and outside Asturias.

- The photographs must be submitted in the formats indicated below and within the duration of the contest, which begins from the moment this announcement is published on the CODEPA website and social media platforms, Asemeyando's Facebook, or the website www.exodos.es , until October 15, 2023.

- Digital Files. The images must be submitted in compressed JPG format, with a minimum size of 5000px on the longest side and a minimum size of 3000px on the shortest side, at 300 dpi, without borders, with the image bleeding to the canvas.

- The photographs should be submitted digitally through the Fotogenius platform: <https://asemeyando.fotogenius.es/>

The submission through the platform should include the author's name and postal address, telephone number, CEF membership number if applicable, and descriptive caption for each photograph submitted, allowing the organizer to exercise their right to reproduce the works in their catalogs or other media as stipulated in these guidelines.

- Participating members of the nursing association, in order to be eligible for all categories of the competition, must mark the box "opt for the association prize."

- The photographs must not have received awards in any other competitions of this contest.

- Signatures, frames, or texts on the images are not allowed.
- The organization reserves the right to accept works that may violate the privacy or dignity of professionals, patients, or institutions.

Exhibition of Works:

- All finalist works will be exhibited on the Official College of Nursing of Asturias website once the submission deadline has ended.
- A selection of finalist images will be part of the exhibition at the award ceremony. This exhibition may be itinerant to promote the contest and its message.
- The Official College of Nursing of Asturias will maintain a photographic archive with all selected images, which may be used for educational, social, and promotional purposes related to the nursing profession.

Deadlines:

- Submission of works: From the publication of the guidelines on the CODEPA website until October 15, 2023.
- Announcement of the jury's decision: Starting from October 22, 2023.
- Publication of photographs selected by the jury: Starting from October 22, 2023.
- Exhibition of works: To be determined based on the availability of the venue.
- Popular vote: To be determined based on the availability of the venue. (It will be conducted in an urn at the venue itself)
- Award ceremony: Starting from November 1, 2023.

Recognition by the CEF:

This contest is recognized by the CEF (Photographic Association) and is eligible for obtaining the titles of Artist, Excellence, and Master of the CEF. Therefore, the contestant authorizes the organizers and the higher CEF entity to process their personal data, solely within the scope of artistic dissemination of their works, and for the publication of their merits and awards aimed at obtaining CEF distinctions.

The organizers and participants are subject to the regulations of the CEF recognition and these guidelines. If any situation is not covered by these rules, it will be reviewed by the organization, which may consult with the CEF, and will be resolved by the Board of Directors.

Acceptance:

Participation implies full acceptance of these guidelines. Any situation not foreseen in them will be resolved by the organization, and their decision will be final and cannot be appealed.

Image and Copyright Rights:

- The author will be responsible for obtaining authorization from individuals, as well as from photographed locations and objects (if required), for the exhibition, publication, and dissemination of the works.

- The participant certifies and guarantees that they are the exclusive and sole author of the works and that the content of the works is not contrary to the law, morality, or public order.

- Works that have been selected and awarded in the contest automatically grant the right to use the image to the CODEPA (Official College of Nursing of Asturias), Asemeyando collaborators, and their higher organizations, such as the CEF (Spanish Confederation of Photography), free of charge, to disseminate the submitted works through their websites, official social media profiles, and other audiovisual media and resources of CODEPA and/or included in their programming.

- For the aforementioned use, participants accept that the materials provided to CODEPA may be edited and combined with images, sound, text, or any other information and/or effects that CODEPA deems appropriate for publication. The authorization mentioned in the preceding paragraph is granted free of charge, and therefore, participants agree that they will not receive any compensation for CODEPA's use of the material.

- The organizers and higher organizations are exempt from any liability in case of third-party image rights claims, always without profit and solely for the purpose of promoting the contest and its message.

- The winners are guaranteed to have their names mentioned in any commercial, advertising, or media support that CODEPA may use to inform and publicize the results of the promotion.

Acceptance of the Guidelines:

Participation in this contest and the submission of photographs in accordance with the provisions of these guidelines implies acceptance of the guidelines and agreement that CODEPA will resolve any issue arising from the contest in which they participate. CODEPA may, to the extent permitted by law, modify the guidelines at any time if circumstances so require. The modification will be announced and will take effect from the date of its announcement, without participants being able to make any claims regarding it, but they may withdraw their works after the modifications are made.

Personal Data:

In accordance with the provisions of Organic Law 3/2018 on the Protection of Personal Data, we inform you that your personal data, as well as the data of individuals who may appear in the works submitted by the author to this contest (particularly the image), will be processed by the data controller: Official College of Nursing of the Principality of Asturias (hereinafter referred to as CODEPA, C/ Juan Antonio Álvarez Rabanal 7, ground floor, 33011, Oviedo), with ASEMEYANDO also being a joint controller. The email address of the data protection delegate is dpdcodepa@jmconsultores.es.

The purpose for which the data will be processed is to manage the works submitted to the contest and relate them to each author, promote and publicize the authors who have been nominated or won an award according to the provisions of the Participation Guidelines, and manage the payment of the awarded works. It is also possible that the works may be published on CODEPA's media, website, and social media.

The legal basis for the processing is your consent when registering on the ASEMAYANDO platform, declaring that you have read and accepted the Contest Guidelines and the Data Protection Policy.

Once the contest is concluded, the data will be stored in CODEPA's computer infrastructure indefinitely unless you exercise your right to deletion, objection, or limitation.

CODEPA undertakes to fulfill its obligation of confidentiality with regard to the provided data and to treat it confidentially. Necessary measures have been taken to prevent alteration, loss, misuse, alteration, unauthorized access, and/or theft of the provided data.

If the image contains personal data of individuals other than the participant (e.g., portraits), the participant declares that they have informed and obtained the explicit, prior, and unequivocal consent of each interested party to carry out the intended data processing, thereby releasing CODEPA from any claim arising from non-compliance.

The data subject may exercise their ARSOPOL rights regarding the personal data processed according to CODEPA's records of activities at any time by requesting it through any means that provides evidence of sending and receiving, clearly expressing their wishes, accompanying a copy of their ID card, and providing any necessary documents to prove their identity, as well as the reasons justifying the exercise of their rights. If any of the rights of objection, deletion, or revocation of granted consent are exercised, the participant will not be able to participate in the contest.

If you do not consent to the processing of data for the purposes outlined here, or if the person you have photographed does not consent to the processing and use of their image in accordance with these guidelines, please do not submit works to the competition.

Data subjects who believe that their exercise of rights has not been properly addressed may also file a complaint with the Spanish Data Protection Agency.
