

33 "VILA DE CAMBRILS" PHOTOGRAPHY AWARD Organized by the AGRUPACIÓ FOTOGRÀFICA CAMBRILS

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. The 33rd Vila de Cambrils Photography Award is open to all photographers from around the world except for people related to the jury. Only those works and/or authors that do not conform to these rules may be rejected.

2. The works accepted at the 33rd Vila de Cambrils Photography Award will score for recognition by the FIAP, the CEF and the FCF.

3. All participants will receive a link to download the awarded and selected works with the highest quality.

4. The fact of participating implies that the authors authorize the reproduction of their works for the purpose of the dissemination of the 33rd "Vila de Cambrils" Photography Award and of photography in general, without limitations of systems, media or countries and without payment of rights.

5. The prize-winning photographs will remain in the archives of the Cambrils Photographic Group for its photo library, reserving the right to reproduce them freely (catalogues, posters, press, reports, etc...), without encouragement for profit and always citing the name of the author.

6. Contestants certify the authorship of their works and take full responsibility that there are no third-party rights, as well as any claim for image rights, of the works presented.

7. The decisions of the jury are final.

8. Participating in the 33rd Vila de Cambrils Photography Award presupposes full acceptance of the present rules.

9. Any unforeseen issue will be resolved by the organization.

10. For the mere fact of presenting his/her images or files in a salon under FIAP Sponsorship, the participant accepts without exception and without objection that the images presented may be investigated by FIAP to establish whether they obey the regulations of the FIAP and definitions even if the participant is not a member of FIAP; FIAP that will use all means at your disposal for this undertaking; that any refusal to cooperate with the FIAP or refusal to present the original files as collected in the chamber, or lack of sufficient evidence, will be sanctioned by the FIAP and that in case of sanctions following the lack of compliance with the rules of the FIAP, the participant's name will be made known in any way useful to report violations of the rules. It is recommended to leave the EXIF data in submitted files intact in order to facilitate eventual investigations.

PARTICIPATION:

1. Participation is exclusively in digital format and through the website http://www.afCambrils.com and www.fotogenius.es

2. A maximum of four works may be presented per section. The same photograph cannot be submitted to more than one section.

3. The images will be in JPG format. The maximum dimension will be 2500 pixels on the largest side with a resolution of 300 dpi. Each file will have a minimum size of 1.5 MB and a maximum size of 2 MB.

4. Registration fees will be €20 and payment will be made exclusively by PayPal

5. The works, whose authors do not comply with all the conditions of participation and/or have not paid the registration fees, will not be accepted.

CHARMAIN SPECIAL AWARD:

Trophy awarded by the director of the show to a photograph, whether or not it was awarded by the jury.

(*) Monochrome definition

(This definition replaces Document 223 and INFO 1991-1912)

A black and white work going from the darkest gray (black) to very light gray (white) is a monochrome work with the different shades of gray.

A black and white work, spinning entirely in one color, will remain as a monochrome work and may appear in the black and white category; this work can be reproduced in black and white in the catalog of a salon under Patrocini FIAP.

Conversely, a black and white work modified by a partial toning or the addition of a color becomes a color (polychrome) work must be listed in the color category; this work needs color reproduction in the catalog of a salon under Patrocini FIAP.

(**) Definition portrait

Photographic portraiture is a genre that brings together a whole series of artistic initiatives that revolve around the idea of showing the physical or emotional qualities of the people who appear in the photographic images.

(***) Natural definition

Nature photography is a modality of the broad photographic subject that attempts to frame on paper the grandeur of landscapes, fauna, flora and small details. Nature photography tends to focus your attention on capturing aesthetic aspects, far more than other types of photography, and includes:
